Sec. 3-1. - Structure of governing body; voting.

The governing body of the Town of Kitty Hawk shall be a Town Council composed of four members and a Mayor. The Mayor shall also have the same right to vote as a member of the Town Council.

Sec. 3-2. - Manner of election of town council.

The qualified voters of the entire Town of Kitty Hawk shall elect the members of the town council.

Sec. 3-3. - Term of office of the members of town council.

Members of the town council are elected to four-year terms. In 1981 all five members of the town council shall be elected, three for four years and two for two years, the three candidates receiving the highest number of votes to serve for four years and the two candidates who receive the next largest number of votes to serve for two years. In 1983 and quadrennially thereafter, two members shall be elected. In 1985 and quadrennially thereafter, three members shall be elected.

Sec. 3-4. - Election of mayor; term of office.

The Mayor shall be elected by all the qualified voters of the Town for a term of 4 (four) years.

Sec. 3-5. - Appointment of initial town council and mayor.

Paul W. Parker, David P. Pruitt, Jr., Samuel O. Smith, Carlton P. Smith, and Sidney C. Toler are hereby appointed members of the town council to serve until their successors are elected in the 1981 election. Paul W. Parker is appointed mayor of the Town of Kitty Hawk to serve until his successor is elected at the organizational meeting of the town council following the 1981 election of town council members.
