Police Station Update

Demolition on a portion of the future Police Station began in early January. The actual demolition is complete. For the next several weeks they will be working on concrete removal and debris milling.

The design schematic is complete and we currently have an active Request for Qualifications to handle the next phase of the project, which will consist of construction document development, site planning and overseeing the contractor bidding process. The link to the RFQ is here.

Chief Johnson has served as the Town's Chief for over 10 years and has made numerous changes within the department during his tenure as Chief to include:


- obtaining grant funds to upgrade firearms

Kitty Hawk Fire Rescue Offering CPR Training for the Community

Kitty Hawk Fire Rescue has begun offering the community monthly Adult and Pediatric CPR training. Our first course was offered on January 11th and 12th and was a huge success.



The Adult and Pediatric CPR/AED course incorporates the latest science and teaches students how to respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies to help victims of any age - adults (about 12 years and older) and pediatric (infants and children up to 12 years of age).

We will also be offering a course called Stop the Bleed. This course teaches the basics of identifying and treating life-threatening bleeding using tourniquets, wound packing, and pressure dressings. We are currently working on scheduling both CPR and Stop the Bleed Courses through April and will announce the dates soon. Call 261-2666 for more information.

These are American Red Cross courses provided by OBXCPR, INC., a North Carolina Non-Profit, and free to the public.

Police Officer III, Tyler Kouskouris was recently promoted to Patrol Sergeant.



Update on NCDOT Paving Project in Kitty Hawk

We have been receiving questions regarding the incomplete paving work on the bypass and side streets, as well as the low visibility conditions in the evening especially when it is raining. Town staff have been in close contact with NCDOT personnel. Currently, the contract does not allow for any paving until March 15, due to the winter temperatures. The contractor has applied for a waiver and is awaiting response. There is no timeline to start at this point. We will provide an update as soon as information becomes available.
