Kitty Hawk Beach

The Town of Kitty Hawk prides itself on providing a public beach for the enjoyment of fulltime residents and visitors alike. There are many public beach accesses, with on and off-street parking available. Residents and visitors are reminded that when parking on a street, the vehicle must be completely off the roadway. There are public parking lots at the Kitty Hawk Bath House, Lillian, and Byrd St. accesses. There is limited street parking at the Bleriot and Luke St. accesses. Also, seasonal port-o-potties can be found at the Byrd, Bleriot, and Luke St. accesses.



Dogs in Kitty Hawk

In public, dogs must be kept on a leash no longer than 12 ft. and in control of the handler. A valid Rabies Tag should always be displayed. All handlers are required to pick up after their dog. Dogs are allowed on the beach, 10:00 am to 6:00 pm from Memorial to Labor Day. Dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6 ft., at other times, dogs may be taken off leash, but must be within 30 ft. of owner and cannot interfere with other beach goers.



Paul Pruitt, Jr. Multi-Use Path

This 2 mile path runs from the intersection of W. Kitty Hawk Rd. and The Woods Rd. north along The Woods Rd., to the intersection of Hwy. 158 E. There is also a connection at the Twiford St. intersection running .8 miles westward along Twiford St. through Kitty Hawk Village.



Kitty Hawk Park

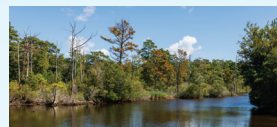
Features include a skateboard park, playground, covered picnic area with grills, walking trail and a dog park. Residents and property owners need to contact Dare County Parks and Recreation at 475-5850 to obtain a permit to utilize the dog park or to reserve the picnic area. The park is open daily from 7:00 a.m. until sunset. The **Kitty Hawk Park Connector Trail** provides access to a 1.8 mile nature trail in the Kitty Hawks Wood Reserve known as the Birch Lane Trail.



Town Hall Trail

101 Veterans Memorial Dr.

A 1-mile natural surface loop trail that circles Kitty Hawk Town Hall, perfect for horseback riding (horses must be registered with the Town of Kitty Hawk), biking, walking, and jogging. Enjoy the natural surroundings and get some exercise while taking in the sights and sounds of nature. Take a break and relax at one of the convenient picnic tables along the way.



Sandy Run Park

4343 The Woods Rd.

Recreational areas include a playground and half basketball court. Picnic areas with grills are also available in the front of the park. A bridge connects to a half-mile nature walk loop over Sandy Run. The nature walk features two gazebos with pedestrian and canoe/kayak access, a nature observation tower, a fishing pier (catch and release please!) picnic tables, benches and interpretive signage. Sandy Run Park is home to a bale of friendly turtles that are fun to watch. **Please do not feed.**



Paul Pruitt, Jr. Park

5160 The Woods Rd.

The fenced in area just off The Woods Rd. (next to Dominion Power) has swing sets and a play area designed for younger children. **Dogs are not allowed in the fenced in area.**



Monument to a Century of Flight

5230 N. Croatan Hwy.

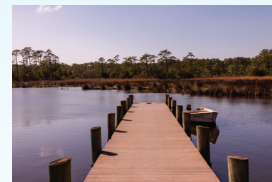
Set against the open sky of Kitty Hawk on the Outer Banks of North Carolina, where flight began, the Monument to a Century of Flight provides a reflective and contemplative environment. It is surrounded by the simple beauty of the barrier island's natural vegetation and looks out toward the waters of the Atlantic.



Windgrass Circle Park

3613 Windgrass Circle

Windgrass Circle Park is located on the Kitty Hawk Bay at the end of Tateway Rd. There is an open deck area with beautiful sunset views. The shoreline offers access to calm shallow waters for wading, canoeing, kayaking and paddle boarding. The park is open daily from 9:00 AM until one hour after sunset. The park also offers access to the Wright Brothers Multi Use Path which is located adjacent to Moore Shore Rd.

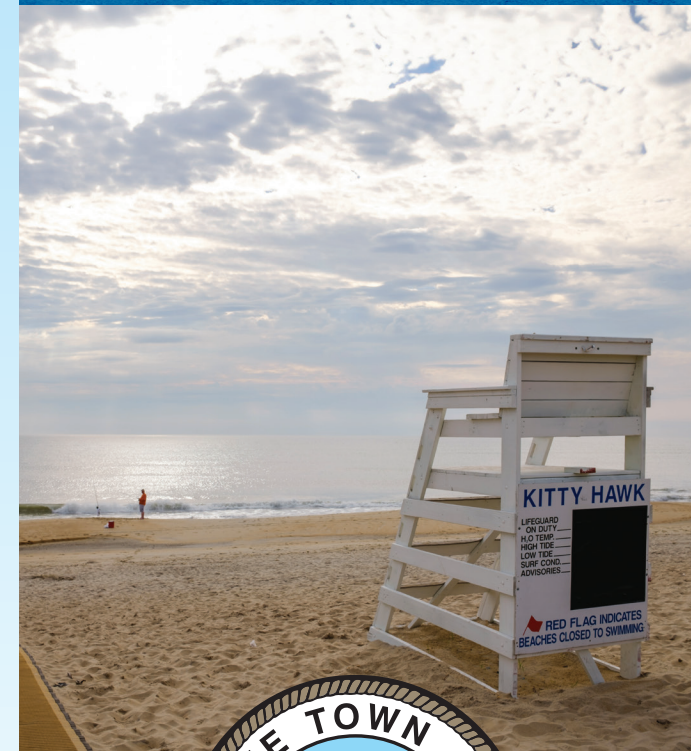


Bob Perry Boat Ramp / Recycle Center
