

### The Town of Kitty Hawk

Located on the Outer Banks of North Carolina, the Town of Kitty Hawk offers year-round residents and visitors alike a unique and relaxing environment.

The Town consists of a thriving Village that has been around for generations, a newer beach community of residential cottages and provides a public beach for the enjoyment of fulltime residents and visitors alike. There is also a maritime forest called Kitty Hawk Woods. The Woods feature a wide variety of plant and animal life.



### Paul Pruitt, Jr. Multi Use Path

The 2 mile David Paul Pruitt Multi-Use Path runs from the intersection of W. Kitty Hawk Rd. and The Woods Rd. north along The Woods Rd., to the intersection of Hwy. 158 E., to the Shoreside (Wal-Mart) Shopping Center, approximately a .5 mile distance. There is also a connection at the Twiford St. intersection running .8 miles westward along Twiford St. through Kitty Hawk Village.



### Paul Pruitt, Jr. Park

5160 The Woods Rd.

The fenced in area just off The Woods Rd. (next to Dominion Power) has swing sets and a play area designed for younger children. **Dogs are not allowed in the fenced in area.**

### Kitty Hawk Beach

The Town of Kitty Hawk prides itself on providing a public beach for the enjoyment of fulltime residents and visitors alike. There are many public beach accesses, with on and off-street parking available. Residents and visitors are reminded that when parking on a street, the vehicle must be completely off the roadway. There is a parking lot at the Kitty Hawk Bath House as well as the Lillian St. access. There is also a public parking lot and port-o-potty at Byrd St. located just south of the intersection of Kitty Hawk Rd. and NC 12.



### Sandy Run Park

4343 The Woods Rd.

Sandy Run Park is located at 4343 The Woods Rd. The park offers public access to the Kitty Hawk Woods Maritime Forest. Recreational areas include a half basketball court. Picnic areas with grills are also available in the front of the park. A bridge connects to a half-mile nature walk loop over Sandy Run. The nature walk features two gazebos with pedestrian and canoe/kayak access, a nature observation tower, a fishing pier (catch and release please!) picnic tables, benches and interpretive signage.

A small children's play area and two fitness stations will be added by 2019. Sandy Run Park is home to a bale of friendly turtles that are fun to watch. **Please do not feed.**



### Windgrass Circle Park

3613 Windgrass Cir.

Windgrass Circle Park is located on the Kitty Hawk Bay at the end of Tateway Rd. There is an open deck area with beautiful sunset views. The shoreline offers access to calm shallow waters for wading, canoeing, kayaking and paddle boarding. The park is open daily from 9:00 AM until one hour after sunset. The park also offers access to the Wright Brothers Multi Use Path which is located adjacent to Moore Shore Rd.



### Kitty Hawk Park

900 West Kitty Hawk Rd.

Kitty Hawk Park is located at 900 W. Kitty Hawk Rd. and is operated by Dare County. There is a skateboard park, playground, covered picnic area with grills, walking trail and a dog park located within the park. Residents and property owners need to contact Dare County Parks and Recreation at 475 - 5850 to obtain a permit to utilize the dog park or to reserve the picnic area. The park is open daily from 7:00 a.m. until sunset.



### Monument to a Century of Flight


5230 N. Croatan Hwy.

Set against the open sky of Kitty Hawk on the Outer Banks of North Carolina, where flight began, the Monument to a Century of Flight provides a reflective and contemplative environment. It is surrounded by the simple beauty of the barrier island's natural vegetation and looks out toward the waters of the Atlantic.

### Bob Perry Boat Ramp/ Recycle Center

4190 Bob Perry Rd.

Boat Ramp to launch kayaks, jet skis, canoes and boats. Grills and Picnic area. Adjacent to Town's Recycle Center.



### Dogs in Kitty Hawk

In public, dogs must be kept on a leash no longer than 12 ft. and in control of the handler. A valid Rabies Tag should always be displayed. All handlers are required to pick up after their dog. Dogs are allowed on the beach, 10:00 am to 6:00 pm from Memorial to Labor Day. Dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6 ft., at other times, dogs may be taken off leash, but must be within 30 ft. of owner and cannot interfere with other beach goers.
